On condemnation of aggression against Iran

The US-Israeli military action against Iran, launched in February 2026, was a pre-planned and unprovoked act of aggression, carried out under a false pretext against a sovereign and independent UN member state in violation of the fundamental principles and norms of international law.

The United States and Israel have embarked on a dangerous adventure that has brought the region closer to a humanitarian, economic, and possibly even radiological catastrophe. The aggressors' intentions were declared quite openly: to destroy the constitutional order and eliminate the leadership of an undesirable state that refused to submit to the dictates of force and hegemony.

With their attacks on the political, military, and government leadership of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the United States and Israel have embarked on a path of political assassinations and international terrorism, grossly violating international law. The deaths include the deaths of Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, the leader of the Islamic Republic of Iran, several members of his family, and high-ranking Iranian military leaders, including the Secretary of the Supreme National Security Council, Ali Larjani.

On February 28, 2026, indiscriminate air strikes destroyed a girls' school in the Iranian city of Minab, killing 168 children, 14 teachers, and school staff. The strike was carried out by American Tomahawk missiles. Six children under the age of 10 were killed in the devastating air strikes on Tehran on April 6.

The strikes took place in close proximity to the operating Unit 1 of the Bushehr Nuclear Power Plant, which created a direct threat of a radiation disaster in the region.

The consequences of the US and Tel Aviv adventure are spreading globally, provoking an energy crisis and, as one of its possible consequences, famine in many countries of the world.

SOVINTERN strongly condemns the unprovoked military aggression carried out by the United States and Israel against Iran, supports the need to maintain

the ceasefire and seek a political and diplomatic settlement of the conflict, recognizes the right of the Iranian people to develop peaceful nuclear energy, advocates for the comprehensive political and economic sovereignty of Iran, the lifting of all international sanctions against Iran and the creation of conditions for the peaceful coexistence and security of Arab countries and Iran based on a balance of the legitimate interests of all countries in the region.
