On the need to lift the economic, commercial and financial blockade imposed by the United States against Cuba

The International Socialist Network SOVINTERN condemns the escalation of tensions, sanctions and the blockade of Cuba, which is organized by the United States.

For many years, the United States has been implementing a trade, economic, financial, and, more recently, energy embargo against the Island of Freedom, in violation of international law.

The International Socialist Network SOVINTERN expresses its support for the heroic Cuban people, who have repeatedly demonstrated their devotion to the ideals of socialism, freedom, independence, and social justice, as well as unparalleled resilience and courage in the face of external threats. We are confident that fraternal Cuba will be able to defend its inalienable right to a sovereign choice of its own development path.

The International Socialist Network SOVINTERN calls for the lifting of all illegally imposed sanctions against the island.

SOV INTERN notes that throughout its revolutionary history, Cuba has provided aid to countries in Latin America, Africa, Asia, and Oceania in need. Cuba has provided more medical personnel to developing countries than all the G7 countries combined. In 1960, 1972, and 1990, Cuba sent emergency aid teams to Chile, Nicaragua, Iran, Venezuela, Honduras, Guatemala, Haiti, Sri Lanka, and Pakistan following natural disasters, and to combat Ebola in West Africa. Cuban doctors have provided assistance in the fight against COVID- 19 in 40 countries, including the EU, Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, and the Middle East.
